



Gleneagles Hospital Kuala Lumpur's AHAH charity programme offers medical intervention to children from low-income families who face congenital heart diseases at zero cost.

When it was first launched in 1996 (in collaboration with The New Straits Times), we aimed to support at least 10 children a year. Since then, the AHAH programme has benefitted **more than 1,400 children** for the past 25 years.

Projects and initiatives include:

- a. The "Embrace the Gift of Life" Charity Project Organized in conjunction with Shangri-La Hotel, Kuala Lumpur, donations from this charity funded 11 children's life-saving heart surgeries in 2019.
- b. Your Heart, Our Rhythm 12 recovered beneficiaries from the AHAH programme were treated to a special day out at Sunway Lagoon Wildlife Park in 2019.

- c. Sponsor A Kid for Eid Sponsors lower-income children with new baju Raya so they can dress up from head to toe for the festive season.




